

Procurement Technical Assistance Centers (PTACs)

Authorized by Congress to expand the number of small businesses capable of participating in government contracts.

2024


The National Defense

We assist Maine businesses to participate in the government marketplace.



HUBZone

The federal government tries to award at least 3% of all federal prime contracting dollars to HUBZone-certified small businesses each year.



Women-Owned Small Business

The federal government tries to award at least 5% of all federal contracting dollars to women-owned small businesses each year.



Service-Disabled Veteran-Owned

The federal government tries to award at least 3% of annual federal contracting dollars to service-disabled veteran-owned small businesses.



- Perform opportunity assessments
 & self-assessments
- Proofread proposals to ensure offer is responsive and responsible

- Review contract & performance specifications

Qualifications:

Any business of any service can become DBE certified in Maine.

Businesses can only qualify for the Supportive Services offered through EMDC when they are 51% minority/women-owned, their personal net worth doesn't exceed \$1.32 million, and they offer a MaineDOT service (environmental consulting, construction, engineering, etc.)
